My passion is the hand building of Raku and Stoneware ceramics.

Working from my studio in Bledlow Ridge on the borders of Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire specialising in decorative pots and vessels greatly inspired by Gothic, Celtic, Aboriginal and African motifs which can be seen in the carved designs that seem typical of my Stoneware work.

With the Raku work a more 'graphical' style is used with designs tending to be more 'Geometric' and using the properties of this firing technique to create bold statements.

Most of my work is hand built using two main techniques 'Slab' and 'Coil'. Firing is done either using a electric kiln or one of my gas fired Raku kilns.

I teach and hold workshops in the Bucks, Berks & Oxon area, mainly at the Phoenix Studio in Towersey, Oxon. Weekend 'all inclusive' workshops can also be arranged at 'Mole Cottage' a beautiful river side 16th century cottage in the heart of the South Devon countryside.
